### Write Linear Equations in Slope-Intercept Form

#### Big Ideas

1. How to identify the slope and y-intercept when an equation is in slope-intercept form.
2. How to find the slope and y-intercept from a graph and then write an equation.
3. How to write a function in slope-intercept form when given values of  $f(x)$ .

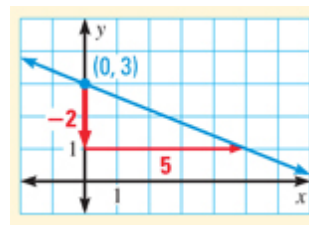

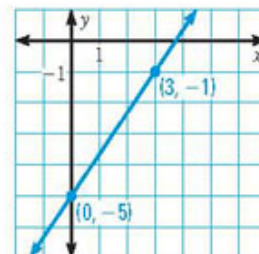
